Practices Offered by Marianist Communities

Prayer:

- **Extra time of prayer; Holy Hour
- **Extra time for rosary, personally
- **Pray Psalm 51 at morning/evening prayer
- **Attend Mass at Ministry for victims
- **Attend the Ministry Mass "For Forgiveness of Sins"
- **Attend a prayer service sponsored by Campus Ministry
- **Include petition at daily Mass
- **Pray the rosary in community once per week.
- **Use a special prayer written by a community member
- **As a community celebrated a votive mass for healing
- **Special prayer
- **Will use the prayer for healing
- **Offer the community evening rosary for this intention
- **The community prayed for thirty minutes in silent prayer for the victims and their healing.
- **Prayed the prayer for reconciliation at community Mass
- **Each day at Mass, they will be adding a prayer on the sexual abuse crisis.
- **Parish will offer extra confession times.
- **Special penitential Rite will be used at Mass
- **Join the Archdiocese in the Friday, Sept. 7th day of public repentance and humble contrition.
- **Fridays, we will use penitential prayers at our Eucharist.
- **Include an intercession for all involved in the child abuse crisis in all our community Eucharists
- **Friday, September 7: We will use our meditation time before Eucharist specifically to pray for all involved.
- **Specific intention at our morning and evening prayer for openness, transparency and forgiveness for our Church for this next week and once a week there after.

Penance:

- **No meat for several days
- **No ice cream for a week
- **Simple soup/bread supper in the community
- **Penance will be up to each individual brother
- **Simple meal one day
- **Pray the rosary for this intention
- **Once a month (Friday), until the end of the year, we will have a simple meal
- **Each brother in the community will do a personal penance for the sexual abuse.

Other Acts:

- **Extra effort to be "Men of Hope and Joy"
- **Decided to double our efforts at recruitment as a continuing act of reparation.
