And Jacob the father of Joseph the husband of Mary, of whom Jesus was born, who is called Christ.

Now the birth of Jesus Christ took place in this way. When his mother Mary had been betrothed to Joseph, before they came together she was found to be with child of the Holy Spirit; and her husband Joseph, being a just man and unwilling to put her to shame,

resolved to send her away quietly. But as he considered this, behold, an angel of the Lord appeared to him in a dream, saying, "Joseph, son of David, do not fear to take Mary your wife, for that which is conceived in her is of the Holy Spirit; she will bear a son, and you shall call his name Jesus, for he will save his people from their sins.

When Joseph woke from sleep, he did as the angel of the Lord commanded him; he took his wife.

Contemplate the following text from the writings of Father Chaminade on St. Joseph, Spouse of Blessed Virgin Mary, and Patron of the Society of Mary.

....What a gift of prudence he must have received for the Lord to have thus set him up as head of his family, over God's Son and God's daughter, over Jesus and Mary. But also, what an honor to enter thus into an alliance with the heavenly Father's family, to become the third person of this created trinity! Saint Joseph enters into an alliance, properly so-called, with the divine family. By becoming the spouse of Mary, he will henceforth be included in the expression "holy family."
