Death in the Region

On June 23, 2024, the Region of India experienced profound shock upon the loss of our second Indian Marianist Brother. It was deeply saddening to hear of the passing of our beloved Bro. Oscar Kerketta, SM, a member of the Maria Nivas Community in Budakata, Odisha. Bro. Oscar had served the Society of Mary in various roles, including a decade-long mission in the Philippines. He was trained as a formator and contributed extensively to our formation communities over the years. In his final days, he was assigned to teach at the school and oversee the CRDP (Chaminade Rural Development Program), benefiting numerous young people in the area.



The news of his demise on June 23, 2024, came as a shock to us all. His mortal remains were laid to rest at Nirmal Deep in Ranchi, with many paying their respects, including members of the Society of Mary, Daughters of Mary Immaculate, Marianist Lay Communities, neighboring religious communities, local parishioners, teachers from our schools and REDS, Bro. Oscar's

family, and numerous friends. His passing is a significant loss for the recently established Region of India. We humbly request your prayers for his soul and for all who mourn his departure.
